RSO OUSTED MUSICIAN OVER LATE PAY PUB

***BRUSILOV'S VICIOUS ATTACK AT SERVICE CAME AFTER MUSICIAN'S PRESS QUOTE
MUSICIAN'S UNION WILL SEEK LEGAL REMEDY IN RESPONSE TO AMBUSH***

- WHO:** Anshel Brusilow, Music Director and conductor of the Richardson Symphony Orchestra, former Music Director of the Dallas Symphony Orchestra.
- WHAT:** Brusilow launched a vicious personal attack upon the orchestra but more specifically upon RSO principal trumpet player Bert Truax who also serves as chairperson of the orchestra's contract negotiating committee.
- WHERE:** The Charles W. Eisemann Center, 2351 Performance Drive, Richardson, Texas.
- WHEN:** 730pm Friday, May 7, 2010 preceding the RSO's Saturday, May 8, 2010 concert
- WHY:** Brusilow conducted the vicious attack at the opening of a rehearsal service after Bert Truax lent his name to a determination to publicize, through a Musicians' Union [press release](#) and by pre-concert informational leafleting, the RSO's failure and refusal to pay musicians for their services according to contract. Truax and other RSO members leafleted patrons at a May 8 concert because they have had to wait weeks and months to receive their paychecks for most every concert performed over the past two years. Ironically, the leafleting prompted patrons attending the concert to pledge over \$3000 to help management pay orchestra members.
